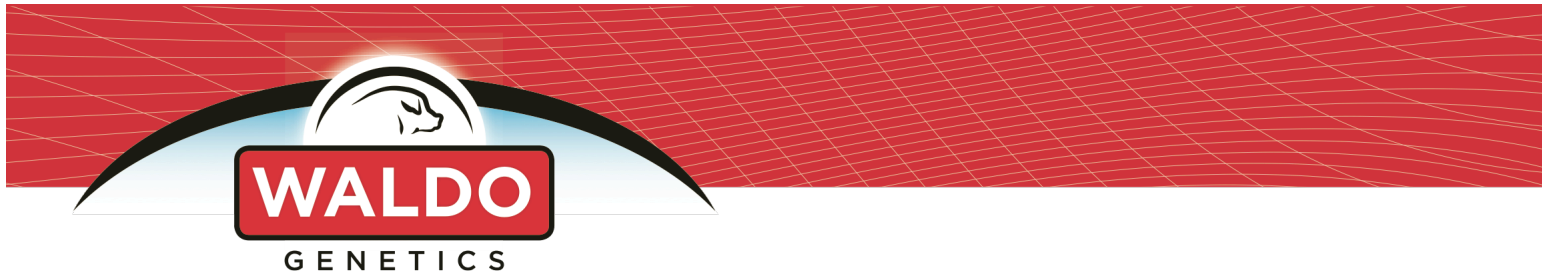




## Waldo Scholarship Application Requirements

- Eligible returning college students will be enrolled in an accredited Bachelor or Post-Grad program in Agriculture or Animal Science with an emphasis on the swine industry
  - Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher (based on 4-point system)
  - Provide copy of college transcript
  - Submit two letters of reference (letters may be sent under separate cover)
  - Deadline: **Applications must be postmarked by May 8, 2015**
- 1) Provide complete resume including Agriculture course work and organization memberships and offices held. Information must include:
    - Name
    - Address
    - Phone Number
    - E-mail Address
    - Major and Minor
    - College Program Director - Cumulative GPA
    - Planned Graduation Date
  - 2) Answer these questions in your application essay using 1,000 total words or less:
    - a. What do you believe are the biggest opportunities for the future of the swine industry?
    - b. What are your long-range professional goals?
    - c. Why are you the best choice for the Waldo Genetics Swine Studies Scholarship?
  - 3) Provide a minimum of two references (may include, but are not limited to: faculty, counselors, supervisors, current employers, but no family members, please). Each reference must include the relationship to the applicant, contact information and specific examples of professional growth and achievement in the swine studies.
  - 4) Follow Waldo Genetics on Twitter and Facebook. Comment about your application for the scholarship and Share.
